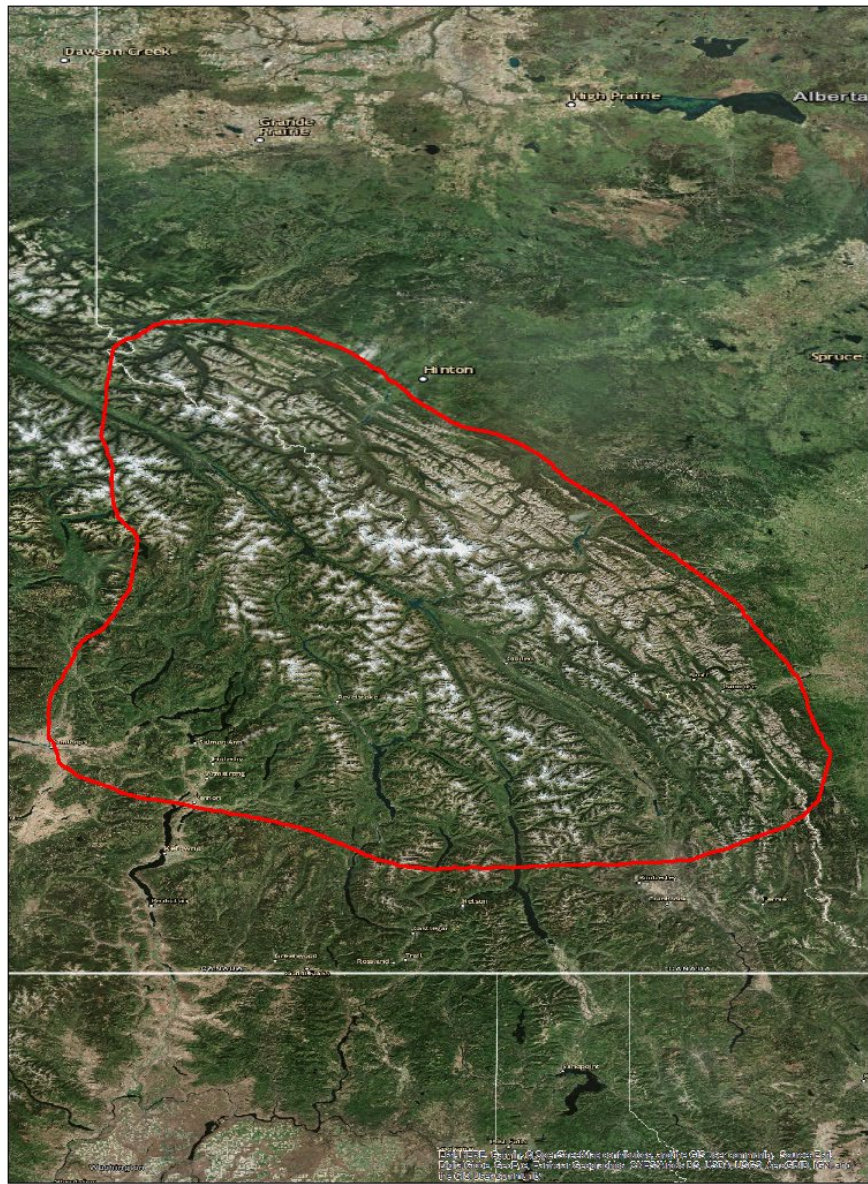

# LSLB Current Referrals Process

- 1. Receive notification re. Crown Lands & Water Act**  
BC & Federal Govt (SWAP, mail, email etc)  
Licensees (Forestry etc)  
Proponents (Recreational etc)  
Property Owners (ie. development on archaeology sites)
- 2. Ask for missing files (ie. kml/kmz), respond to those out of territory immediately, acknowledge receipt**
- 3. Put it in the calendar**
- 4. Analyze-** Using RAAD, Google Earth, LSLB CKK etc
- 5. Send response-**request action (meeting, site visit) or not



**\*Incoming referrals and follow up are constantly ongoing**

**\*Developing prior relationships with First Nations is key**

**\*Consider your relationship with First Nations a partnership**

**\*View your relationship with First Nations as an opportunity**

**\*Remember that capacity and time can be an issue for First Nations**

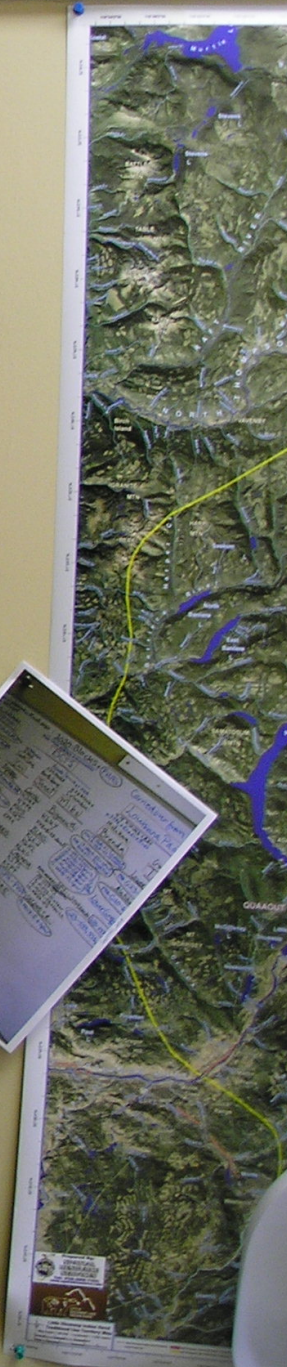
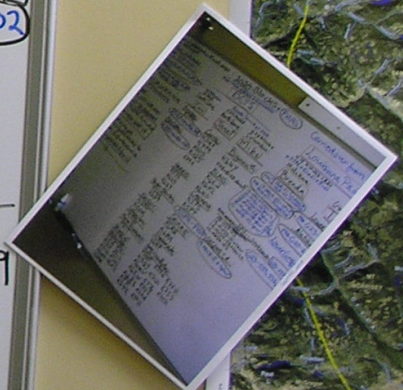

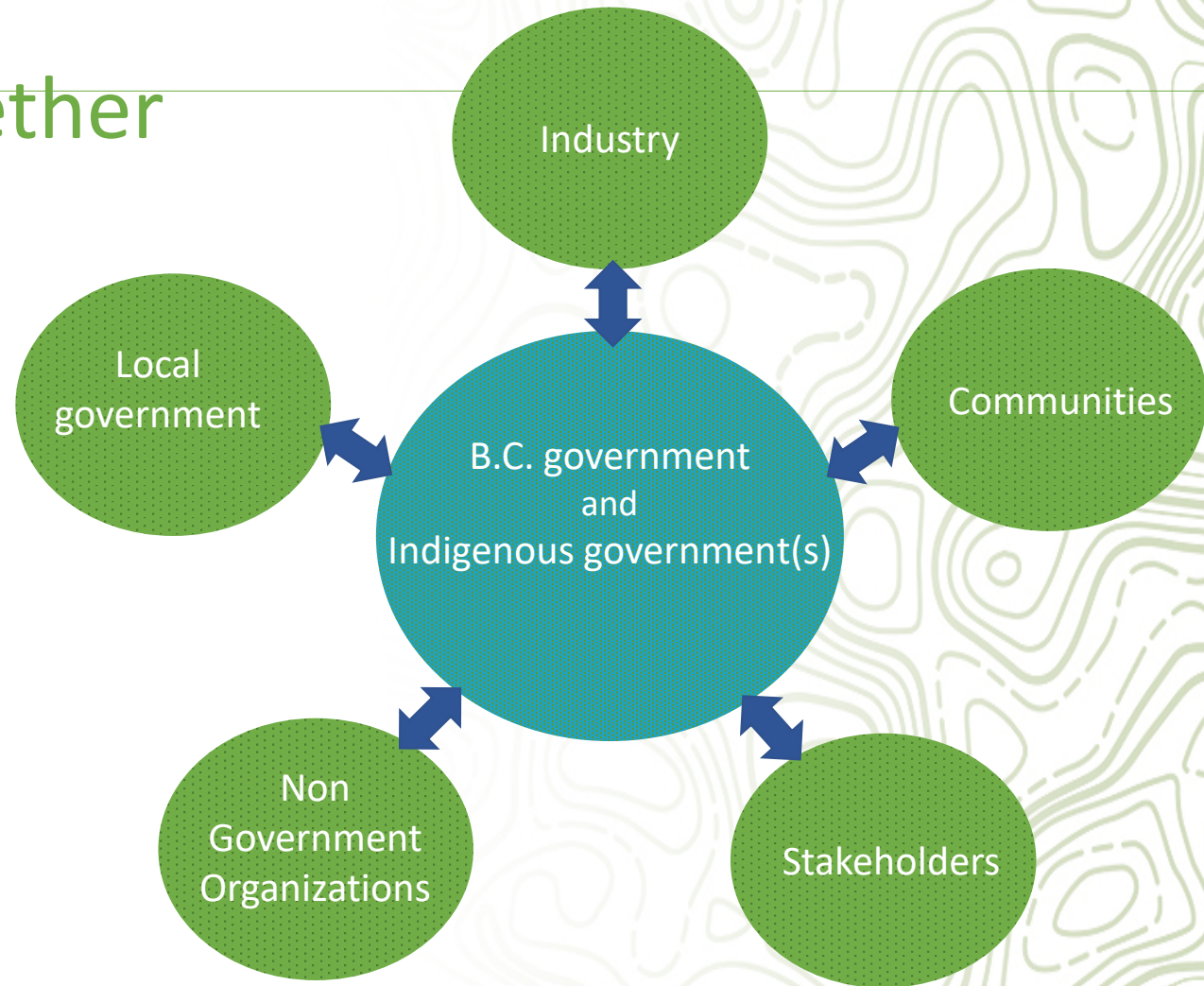
